CRoLEV Objectives and Priorities


- CRoLEV is a Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence (2022-25) which aims to produce outcomes related to both **research and impact** (Objectives 1-3) and **teaching and learning** (Objective 4).
- Objective 1: To explore the actual state of the RoL and European Values in several MS of the EU and neighbouring countries.
- Objectives 2 and 3:
- To develop high-level research on:
 - the deterioration of the RoL/values across the EU and elsewhere;
 - the specific threats the RoL/values face (or might face);
 - the possible ways in which RoL/value protections can be secured;
 - the existing mechanisms the EU has to guard against rule of law backsliding.
- Through the employment of a series of different methodologies and approaches, suitable to achieve valuable and durable outputs with an impact on civil society and policy-makers.
- **Objective 4**: To deliver excellent teaching and research in EU law and related fields and the wide dissemination of research results with a specific and timely focus accessible to the wider community.
- Cross-cutting priorities include impact and knowledge transfer to a number of higher education institutions and organisations across Europe. Participatory approach and mutual learning.
