

Dr Alexandra M. Uibariu, CRoLEV Post-Doctoral Researcher

Alexandra M. Uibariu is a Post-Doctoral Researcher at the Centre for the Rule of Law and European Values. She has completed her doctoral studies and submitted her PhD thesis entitled “A Theory of State Crimes Against Democracy (SCADs) in Contemporary Polities” at the University of Portsmouth in December 2022. Alexandra also holds a BSc (Hons) in Criminology and Criminal Justice and an MRes in Criminology and Criminal Justice from the University of Portsmouth. Her research interests include the subversion of democratic regimes by elected or appointed political actors, rule of law and legitimisation, and neoliberal influences on contemporary democratic politics. Prior to joining the University of Central Lancashire in Cyprus, Alexandra was a Teaching Fellow at the University of Portsmouth, where she taught various modules (at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels of study) on crimes committed by states and other powerful actors, international criminal law, and criminological theory.
